

New direction towards clinical research since 2018

- Increase collaboration between clinical and experimental research (KI-Region Stockholm)
- Increase awareness of CIMED
- Increased transparency
- Reduce saved funds



New calls since 2018 -1

1. Samverkansbidrag - to stimulate new collaborations

- One clinician + one experimental researcher
- Call open: spring 2018
- Budget: 7.25 MSEK
- 29 of 43 applications funded (67%)

2. Clinical research time

- For clinicians active at least 50% in the clinic
- Junior and senior
- Call open: spring 2018 decision fall 2018
- 1-3 months per year for up to three years (2019, 2020, 2021)
- Call announced trough Region Stockholm web platform
- External review 22 of 38 applications funded (58%)

New calls since 2018 -2

3. Nätverksbidrag - to stimulate networks that promote clinical research

- Network activity that promotes future clinical research projects at Campus Flemingsberg
- Call open spring 2019
- Budget: 1.0 MSEK (2019-2020)
- 8 of 21 applications funded (38%)

4. Project grant

- For clinicians and experimental researchers with clinical or translational projects
- Up to 2 MSEK/year for three years
- Junior and senior
- Call announced through Region Stockholm web platform
- Call opens spring decision summer/fall
- External review

Results of CIMED project grant 2020-2022

New routines for use of CIMED grants

Background

April 2019 Region Stockholm decided that CIMED was obliged to pay back the surplus from 2018 closure (11.9 MSEK).

Consequence

- > All CIMED grants have to be used by end of December
- > Saved funds must be payed back
- > Parental leave or sick leave exceptions
 - Report expected amount of funding that need to be transfered to the following year no later than September 30th 2019
- ✓ We recommend a continuous dialogue with your financial officer to make sure your CIMED funds are being used as planned in your budget.

A. Financial reporting


- CIMED follows balances on all CIMED accounts

 please report to CIMED by September 30th 2019 the latest.



Planned future calls 2020

Project grants for 2021-2023

- Some changes based on experience from the last call
- Application form is provided with headings
- New rules for junior and senior qualifications
- External review as before
- Application period spring 2020

Strategic recruitments

- Priority list of competencies needed at Campus Flemingsberg to CIMED board every year (coordinated by Maria Eriksdotter)
- Recruiting head of dept. presents candidate to CIMED => final decision
